FINANCIAL POSITION DEC 2023

- We ended the year well- better than we expected.
- In 2023 we budgeted for expenses totaling \$390,153 and income totaling \$315,215. We started the year with \$68,721 of unrestricted funds.
- In 2023 our expenses were less than budgeted at \$396,360 (including principal payments on loans and grantfunded improvements), and our income was more than budgeted at \$443,315. We ended 2023 with \$98,886 of unrestricted funds in the bank.



FINANCIAL POSITION DEC 2023

- Bank balance as of 12/31/22: **\$275,790.51**
- \$170,488 is restricted for a specific use including \$135,878 in the Capital Campaign Fund
- Leaving **\$98,866** in unrestricted cash after adjusting for current liabilities






